In partnership with the Falmouth Historical Society, MBLWHOI Library, and FCTV Falmouth Public Library is hosting the Mass. Memories Road Show on Saturday, September 26 from 11:00 – 4:00.

What is the Mass. Memories Project?

The Mass. Memories Road Show is a state-wide digital history project that documents Massachusetts history through family photographs and stories.

Falmouth residents can be part of Massachusetts history.

This event is sponsored by Mass Humanities & the Massachusetts Studies Project at UMASS Boston. Over 1,200 photos and stories have already been gathered across the state, with a goal of including all 351 Massachusetts towns & cities.
Local volunteers will scan the photos & videotape the stories behind the photos.
