is a former NASA Astronaut who flew aboard two Space Shuttle flights. Her first mission, STS-115 in 2006, was billed by NASA as one of the most complicated space construction efforts ever conducted, and the STS-115 astronauts had trained longer than any other NASA crew. On this mission, Stefanyshyn-Piper performed two space-walks (EVA's), each over 6 hours in duration. On her second mission, STS-126 in 2008, she was the lead space walker and performed three of the four spacewalks.
