## Phragmites (common reed)

Tara Nye, staff biologist of the Association to Preserve Cape Cod, and Dick Payne, Chairman, Falmouth Wetlands Invasives Steering Committee, will explain the explosive spread and threat of this invasive wetland plant.

This tall non-native plant displaces native species, reduces biodiversity, offers little value for wildlife, chokes waterways and has the potential to dominate our salt marshes, as well as the shorelines of our fresh water ponds. After the talks we will go to the marsh behind the Grange Hall, which contains *Phragmites*, to view it first-hand.
