STRIKE OUT CANCER...ONE FRAME AT A TIME

Six years ago, Friends and Family have formed a bike team called *Team Maureen*. Comprised of family members, friends and EMC co-workers, the Team is inspired by Maureen Duffey Russo, who was born and raised in Hudson. She was diagnosed with cervical cancer in 2003 and was treated at Dana-Farber Cancer Institute. In remission for almost 3 years, the cancer returned in 2006. The aggressive form of cervical cancer took its toll on Maureen, despite her endurance and courageous battle for 6 months. She lost her battle to cancer on December 15th, 2006 at the age of 37. Although battling cancer twice, Maureen never complained and in fact was more concerned for others than herself. She adored her children and was dedicated to all her family members and friends. She had an infectious laugh and a great sense of humor as well as the warmest and most giving heart. This is Team Maureens' 7th year riding in the Pan-Mass Challenge (PMC) and we have raised over \$487,000. The PMC is a 90-200 mile bike-a-thon across Massachusetts that's sole aim is to raise funds for cancer research at Dana-Farber Cancer Institute.
