RWH is guided by an interdisciplinary local steering committee, including representatives from the Town of Falmouth, and the business, residential and science communities. RWH works in collaboration with key local stakeholders and the three major science institutions, WHOI, MBL, and NOAA.



Our strategy is a comprehensive, phased approach for increasing climate resiliency in Woods Hole. This strategy includes development of village-wide design concepts and planning, and will address alternatives for institutional, private, and municipal infrastructure, as well as for natural habitat features and waterways.
