The goal of this full day professional development workshop is to introduce K-12 educators to current research and technology for exploring the deep ocean and develop classroom modules for hands-on learning related to the exciting fields of oceanography and engineering.

Teachers will partner with subject matter experts to develop new concepts for classroom modules while also learning about existing modules developed as part of the Seafloor Science and Remotely Operated Vehicle (SSROV) Camp (www.ssrovcamp.org).

After the workshop, participants will develop the activity further and within 2 months, present their concept to one another via remote video conference. Selected modules will be fabricated and made accessible as requested for use in classrooms nationwide.
