# 2 CONNECTING TO PHYSIOLOGY SERVER

#### CONNECTING ON A MAC

Finder, Go, Connect to Server <a href="mailto:smb://courses.mbl.edu/phy">smb://courses.mbl.edu/phy</a>

Username: MBLAD\pp87925

Password: pp87925

#### **CONNECTING ON WINDOWS**

Go to File Explorer

Right-click on  ${\tt Network}$  in the folder navigation pane

Click on the Map Network Drive option Connect to the server: \\courses.mbl.edu\phy If you need a username and password try:

Username: MBLAD\pp87925

Password: pp87925

# 3 Connecting to Wi-Fi

You should generally use the guest network. If your home institution uses eduroam, you should be able to connect devices that way as well.

#### 3.1 Connecting to the Guest Network

Username: MBL-GUEST
Password: mblguest

#### 3.2 Connecting to the Registered Network

Use for access to course share and printer

Open a browser and you will be redirected to the page below:

http://nac.mbl.edu

Your username and password are the first initial of your given and surname followed by the 5-digit code on your MBL ID badge.

Username: ab12345 Password: ab12345

After pressing "Accept" you should be logged in.

## 4 Connecting to Printers

You must be connected to the MBL Registered Wi-Fi network or MBL Registered wired network.

## 4.1 Printer in the Office

Use this address and name when connecting to the printer in Loeb 352.

IP address: 10.225.3.220 Printer name is: PHYPRT1

## 4.2 Printer in the Breakroom

Use this address and name when connecting to the printer in the kitchen/breakroom. Generally, if you are a student or TA, it is recommended to print to the printer in the kitchen/breakroom.

IP address: 10.225.3.216 Printer name is: PHYPRT2

## 4.3 SECOND-FLOOR PRINTER/SCANNER

To use the printer, save data as a pdf and bring it down to the printer in a memory stick. Get the printer code from the course assistants.

#### 4.4 Connecting on a Mac

On Mac press the "+" in the Printers & Scanners window Select Add Printer or Scanner...
Select the "IP" tab
Type in the IP address in the "Address" box.
The printer should be recognized
Press "Add"

#### 4.5 Connecting on a PC

From the Start Menu, search for Printers & scanners

Alternatively, go to Settings > Devices > Printers & scanners

Select Add Printer or Scanner

The printer should appear on the list.

If it does not, click: The printer that I want isn't listed

Select: Add a printer using a TCP/IP address or hostname Type in the IP address of the printer and the port number (9101) when required.
